Topic: The State of the Hack

During the last twelve years, Marshall has been on the front lines assisting organizations in responding to international computer intrusions, theft of customer credentials, and widespread compromise of sensitive data. During his efforts to resolve these incidents, many similar challenges and issues confronted each organization. During this presentation, Marshall will provide case studies that describe in detail the most recent computer security incidents he has responded to on behalf of these organizations. He will discuss how these incidents impact organizations, and discuss the challenges that each organization faced. Marshall will also share his experiences investigating more than 20 fraud-related intrusions during the past two years. He will demonstrate that each compromise revolved around a single objective: money. Marshall will outline a standard attacker methodology, showing how a computer intrusion was followed by credit card fraud, extortion, or fraudulent purchases – all of which are a type of identity theft.

Marshall Heilman is a Manager at Mandiant with over eleven years experience in computer and information security. His particular areas of expertise include incident response, secure network design and architecture, penetration testing, computer forensic analysis and strategic corporate security development. Mr. Heilman has extensive experience working with the Federal government, defense industrial base, financial industry, telecommunications industry and Fortune 500 companies. He has spoken at multiple security conferences, including OWASP.

Prior to joining Mandiant, Mr. Heilman was a member of the United States Marine Corps (USMC). Mr. Heilman received his Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Arizona State University and his Bachelor of Science in Computer and Information Science (CIS) from University of Maryland University College. He is a Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP), a Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) and holds several SANS security certifications. Mr. Heilman also possesses a Top Secret government security clearance and is a certified Payment Card Industries (PCI) assessor.
